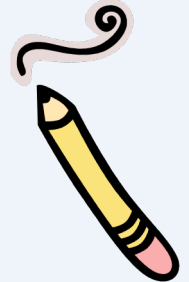
Welcome BridgePrep Families!

Questions & Answers:

(We will attempt to record great questions from parents and answer them here for your consideration)

1. What time should I drop off my child if I do not choose to enroll in before care? *This is a tough one, so please bare with us...our instructions starts promptly at 8 am and our teachers report to work at 7:30am. Therefore, in order to provide teachers time to prepare for the school day we highly encourage children to be dropped off no earlier than 7:45am, unless they are enrolled in before school care @ 5 dollars a day. These 15 minutes allows us to enhance our learning environments, sign in, and receive messages that impact your child's day, supervision is not available until after 7:45 for those not enrolled in before care, please help us keep our children safe.*
2. Where do I purchase a car tag for the car line? *These were in limited stock from last year, and we are looking into purchasing more. Our school budget is limited so be on the look out for preordering tags. We appreciate your patience.*
3. What happens if I'm running late for pick up? *Our student day concludes at 3pm, unless you have enrolled in our after care program (@ 8 dollars a day). We certainly understand that circumstances arise and prevent for a timely pick up. PLEASE always call our office. We want to help! We try to have our pick up line clear by 3:20 Tues-Friday & 2:20 on Monday's. Our staff's professional learning occurs at 3:30pm, 2:30 on Monday's. This is where our staff engages in studies that explore ways to enhance classroom instruction. Late pick-ups impact our ability to communicate and grow professionally, as teacher's workdays conclude at 4pm. Thank you for your consideration & communication.*
