I can hardly believe that we are already halfway through the school year. We came back after Winter Break rested and ready to have fun learning. My students are excited about working on addition and subtraction up to 1000 already with regrouping. When we are working on place value, we have our own abbreviation for HUNDREDS, TENS, AND ONES. We call it H. T. O. Makes it a lot easier and much more fun! We are also using our imagination in Science as we try to think like an engineer. We had fun working in teams to think of ways to improve on the many invention's engineers have made to improve our lives. Then the students came up with future ways to improve on these inventions and presented their "imaginings" to the class. There were some amazing ideas! Second grade will be strengthening their informative writing in February. We will create a biographical paragraph about a famous African American. We will also continue our study of folktales by comparing them, discussing point of view, and learning about traits to describe characters in stories. Welcome to Fifth Grade

In math, we have been working hard adding and subtracting decimals! We have been lining up the place values so that we make sure to do the math correctly.

In science, we have been exploring space! We learned about the Milky Way galaxy, our solar system, and the celestial bodies (the sun, planets, moons, comets, asteroids, and dwarf planets) within it. We created model galaxies that show where the red, yellow, and blue stars are as well as where there is gas and dust in our galaxy, the Milky Way. We took a tour of the solar system that was measured to scale in terms of both the size and distance of the sun and planets. The sun was shrunk down to 10cm and we still had to turn around at Saturn because we didn't want to leave the school grounds!

In Social Studies & Language Arts we began learning about the New England Colonies and have been focusing on explanatory & opinion writing. We look forward to meeting with parents & students for our mid-year conferences this month!

Welcome to 4th grade

In the Month of January, we learned about the Reconstruction Period after the Civil War. The students studied about Florida's Cattle Industry, Sumter and Citrus Counties and ways people use money. We also learned about the phases of the moon, astronomy and how the constellations came to be named. In math, students went in depth about fractions, decimals and rigorous studying of multiplication facts (4th grade is such a key year to learn these facts, it will set students up for math success for years to come when these are mastered).

In the coming week and throughout the month of February, the students will begin a novel study to the book "Frindle." This novel is mainly about a kid named Nick who has a reputation for disrupting class. When he starts fifth grade, he tests his no-nonsense teacher, Mrs. Granger, by asking her who decides what words mean. This results in him inventing a new word, "frindle," which originally means pen. A journalist picks up the "frindle" story, which quickly makes Nick famous.
